The executive of the Institute of Power Engineers would like to invite all Power Engineers in British Columbia to visit our New Website. The address is the same as the old website, www.ipevancouver.ca.

Go to: www.ipevancouver.ca click on **Join**, this is to sign up for access to the website. You will go to a profile page that will allow you to fill in the required information. Enter the username you would like to use and a password of your choice, (the password must have eight letters). You must enter a valid email address and complete the information, then click on the register box. **At this point you will become a registered guest member and be allowed to navigate the website.**

You will receive an automated confirmation e mail from the website. This email contains a link that you must follow within seven days to activate your account.

After you click on the link in the email you will be taken to the www.ipevancouver.ca website and you will see a message thanking you for activating your account.

After registering on the website, the membership committee of the Vancouver Branch will check to see if you are a paid up member of the IPE. If so, they will activate you to **member** status and you will be allowed to access all pages of the website, including the “**employment**” page.

To become a Regular, Associate or a Student member of the Institute of Power Engineers, scroll down the left side of the screen to **Membership** and select the application form required.

Membership Fees: The BCIPE application form and fees can be sent by Canada Post directly to the address on the form. OR You can email the application. At the bottom of the website page is a link to the National website where you can pay your initiation fee and membership dues by Paypal with your Visa, Mastercard or American Express.
