7. New Business

Discussion Re National Convention 2014 and operational committee

8. Safety Talk / Plant Presentation Eric Steinson / Tim Haaf TOPIC Power Generating Station safety and Operation

- Video Presentation and discussion on the Burrard Generating Station in Port Moody

- Started in 1958 and Commissioned in 1961
- Video was shown on the operations of the Plant, Steam coming from the boiler to the turbine and condensate back to the boiler complete cycle
- The plant was upgraded for greater operation and control, reduced emissions, increases in efficiency and reliability.
- There was talk of locking areas and safety in the plant.
